MEMBERSHIP: All members of the Association may be called upon by the members of the Board of Governors to investigate new applicants who may be convenient to the members asked to do so.

FINANCE: No authority for expenditures is to be given by any chairman or individual unless approved by the Finance Committee.

RULES AND POLICIES: This Committee will meet periodically or at any time that their opinion may be required to formulate rules and policies governing the Association.

DOCKS AND BEACHES: This Committee has formulated plans that have met with the entire approval of the Association and everything possible should be done to see that they are completed, and in-as-much as they are so extensive it will require the help of the entire membership. I would like to suggest that the Chairman of this Committee assign to each member certain docks or beaches to be surveyed by them periodically and keep their Chairman posted on all matters requiring attention in this direction.

ROADS: It is the duty of this Committee to observe, recommend, and receive estimates for all repairs, etc., deemed necessary and passed on to the Finance Committee for final disposition.

HOUSE AND GROUNDS: The Chairman of this Committee should assign to each member of his committee certain locations or areas to come under their jurisdiction and report back to the Chairman any objectionable situations.

ENTERTAINMENT: I feel that this Committee should be quite extensive so that the various members of the Committee who may have ideas could contact certain groups to assist them in carrying out their plans.

PUBLICITY: All members are automatically on this Committee and any publicity they may care to have publicized should always be presented to Chairman Hummer for screening and rewrite if necessary. There are to be no exceptions.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE: This Committee will meet the third Sunday during the months of May, June, July and August. Notice will be mailed.

ASSOCIATION MEETINGS: We are going to attempt to hold meetings on the first Sunday of each month during the summer. The first meeting will be in May, as authorized by the By-Laws, and every month thereafter until the final meeting in September. In this manner we hope to renew enthusiasm and interest and, by holding meetings more often, we will be able to keep the Association members posted on all matters pertaining to them. Your response to these meetings by your attendance will be the manner in which we shall decide if they shall continue.
