The following is an excerpt from the By-Laws adopted June 24, 1967 - Article III, Section 2:

DUES: MEMBERS SHALL PAY ANNUALLY ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1st, etc.

In case you are wondering why docks or beaches or certain W.S.P.O.A. properties are not repaired promptly, it is because dues are not paid on time. Each year we pay over \$2800 in taxes and \$777 in insurance before we can repair or buy anything. Our light bill is nearly \$300 a year, and we must pay promissory notes to members from our working capital. Our main source of revenue is dues. Boat moorings cannot be issued unless the dues are paid, so if we do not collect one, we cannot collect the other. We have managed to keep running because some members pay their dues on time, but many do not. Please pay your dues - they are a very small cost and the return in terms of docks, beaches, clubhouse, childrens' activities and the like, is worth the effort.
