PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BY-LAWS  
WILDWOOD SHORES PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION

By resolution of the Board of Governors at a regular meeting held on June 28, 1974, in accordance with Article III, Sec. 2 (A) of the Wildwood Shores Property Owners' Association By-Laws adopted June 24, 1967, it was resolved that a proposed amendment for dues be submitted to the membership at the annual meeting to be held on Saturday, August 31, 1974 at 10:00 A.M. at the Club House. The proposed amendment is to raise the dues from \$40 to \$60 for lots upon which residences are erected and from \$15 to \$20 on vacant lots. The proposed amendment will be open for discussion at the meeting after which a deciding vote will be taken.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Governors held on July 26, 1974, it was resolved that an amendment to the By-Laws be presented to the membership at the annual meeting as stated above. The amendment to be presented to the membership is as follows:

ARTICLE XI, Sec. 2 - USE OF BEACHES.

- A. No animals or pets shall be allowed on the docks or beaches.
- B. No boats shall be washed or cleaned at the docks and beaches with any soap, cleanser or detergent that is not bio-degradable.
- C. The docks and beaches shall not be used for the purpose of bathing with soap or other cleaners.
