

The General Spring Meeting was called to order on June 27, 1981 at 9:15 AM by President, Bob Oliva.

Board Members present were: Morstatt, Pepe, Oliva, Wakefoose, Philblad and Opiekun.

Board Members absent were: Nichols, Kimmerer, Franchino.

Minutes from the Fall Meeting were read by J. Oliva and were accepted. Motion to accept the minutes was made by B. Viola and seconded by Ruprecht.

Treasurer's Report - E. Morstatt reported a current balance as of 6/27/81 was \$2,454.92. One Hundred Four families have paid their dues so far. In August all the delinquent dues will be placed in the hands of the attorney for the 1981 season. There are only two bonds left to pay - Thorber and Philblad.

Badges - 104 families have paid their dues to date.

Moorings - 8 boats at Pebble Beach and 5 boats at Sand Harbor

Docks & Beaches - Discussed associate membership for the Lines Avenue people. Three loads of sand have been delivered. Sand Harbor and the Pool are done. Next year we will due what repairs we can afford on the docks.

Club House - Will be opened but need volunteers to chaperon.

Membership - All monies were paid in full for Hobby's delinquent dues since the house was sold to the Gearys'.

Roads - A problem of holes on Woodland Road have the residents upset. The Borough does not have this road recorded therefore conclusion was that the Association was responsible. A load of crushed stone would probably do the trick.

Legal/Finance - From May 1979 - May of 1980 we paid off \$5,232.76 in bonds and Paid \$3,780 for the loan. From June 1980 - June 1981 we paid \$10,352.64 in bonds and \$1,890 for the loan. From 1979 to 1981 \$21,255 was paid back in bonds and the loan.

Unfinished Business - The lawyer will be taking delinquent people to court very shortly.

New Business - Next year we will have monies for the purchase of fencing to start fencing in our beaches and moorings. This will hopefully discourage intruders at night and protect our assets.

A motion was made to adjourn at 10:00 AM. This motion was seconded and accepted.
