As residents of Wildwood Shores, we are fortunate to live in a community which provides its members with the use of five beaches during the summer. Unfortunately, this privilege is being abused. The beaches and docks, which are maintained by our dues, are being vandalized by many children and teenagers who do not even live in our area. Unfortunately, however, many of our children are also guilty of this destruction.

Last summer we experienced trouble at all of our beaches, but I would have to cite Pebble Beach as the worst abused. Almost every evening, throughout June to September, the people who live around this area were plagued by the arrival of a yelling and screaming gang - from the ages of 10 to 20 - who proceeded to break into boats, slash boat covers, steal batteries, smash beer bottles, leave garbage strewn all over the area, drive cars onto the beach, knock down fences which are on private property etc. If this were happening in your front yard wouldn't you want to put an immediate stop to it? I'm sure you can sympathize with those who have had to put up with this aggravation summer after summer. Instead of being able to enjoy their homes and docks, they are constantly harrassed with this sort of belligerent behavior during the most enjoyable time of the year.

Because of these events, a Beach Patrol has been formed to enforce the following:


- . All persons must wear a current year's badge when using any of the facilities provided by the Wildwood Shores Property Owners Association.
 - Anyone violating this rule will be considered a trespasser and dealt with as such.
- . There is no drinking permitted on any of the beaches.
- . The 10PM curfew will be strictly enforced. The beaches will be patrolled at this hour and anyone present at that time or afterwards will be asked to leave.
- . The parking areas by the beaches are to be used by families who are using the facilities during normal beach hours.
 - They are not to be used as gathering places for drinking, smoking dope, and, once again, shattering glass. If your children drive, or if they have friends who drive, please advise them that this will not be tolerated this year. The police will be called at the first signs of a disturbance.
