The work needed to be done on the kitchen was discussed. Stan, Matt, and Rich will get together in November to start the work. Other members will be contacted there after for help. The bathrooms will be winterized and water turned off.

There was talk of new windows sometime in the future.

Karen Pandorf's request for rental of the club house on October 29th was approved.

Pat Comeau was with us and walking. He has made good progress and will stay on the board until next spring, when he will be evaluated again by doctors. It will then be decided if he can or cannot perform his duties.

No new business was conducted because of the absence of half the board.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
