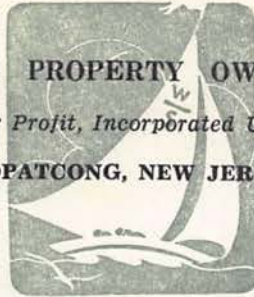

Dear Member:
