At last, there has been placed in the custody of your Committee on Association Properties and Surveys, an authenticated copy of the five Deeds which embrace the transfers to this Association during the past several years, by the Land Company formerly known as Wildwood Shores, Lake Hopatcong, later as the Lake Waterloo Corporation, of the several beaches, roads, trails and the pool, heretofore only reported to have been so transferred.

BYLAWS


